Also, the Navaro faucet family serves as the perfect complement to the Explore™ line of fine fireclay sinks, inspired by the American Southwest, merging warm terra cotta accents and traditional design elements with the functionality needed in today's most demanding kitchens.

Reinforcing its pioneering heritage of more than 89 years, Elkay continues to break new ground by expanding its portfolio of regional designs to offer distinctive sink and faucet solutions. These additions to the portfolio provide total kitchen coordination options for designers and homeowners.

Design details on the base of the handle and spout emulate the smooth, rounded shapes found in Southwestern pottery and are available either finish-matched with the faucet - in oil rubbed bronze, chrome or brushed nickel - or in the eye-catching combination of oil rubbed bronze accented with vibrant terra cotta rings to coordinate impeccably with the Explore fine fireclay sinks.

While the Navaro finished in Elkay’s oil rubbed bronze and terra cotta accents particularly enhances the traditional, Americana attributes of the faucet, its design also blends with a vast range of décors, making a statement even in a transitional Manhattan loft with its chrome and brushed nickel finishes, or pairing perfectly with numerous transitional sink families.

Fashion Meets Function

Personalization and customization of kitchen design has taken on increased importance in today’s economy, with many homeowners choosing to invest in their current properties, as opposed to moving into a new home. In addition to the fact that kitchen remodels remain the number one way to increase home value, 43 percent of homeowners are spending more time in the kitchen, eating in more often than they did just a year ago¹. Designed with the homeowner’s convenience in mind, with features such as 360 degree rotation and a single handle, the Navaro is available as a pull-down (LK9405) or

with a side spray (LK9402) for maximum functionality, efficient food prep and easy clean up. The Navaro family also features a bar faucet (LK9405) and pot filler (LK9441) to enable homeowners to design a multi-functional kitchen with an underlying element of balance throughout the room. For example, the Navaro wall-mounted pot filler faucet makes it easier to fill pots near the cook top by eliminating the need to transport heavy cookware from sink to burner.

All Navaro faucets are compliant with the California Assembly Bill 1953 which goes into effect January 2010, in addition to the existing NSF-61 requirements to fully ensure clean, safe water. Also, each Navaro faucet uses a ceramic disc cartridge to meet national water conservation standards of 2.2 gallons per minute.

The MSRP price range for the Navaro kitchen faucet family is \$713 - \$1,265, depending on the faucet style and finish selected. The Elkay Explore fireclay sinks MSRP pricing ranges from \$610 to \$1,499.

For more than 89 years, Elkay has been an innovative manufacturer of stainless steel sinks, water coolers, drinking fountains and faucets for residential and commercial use.
