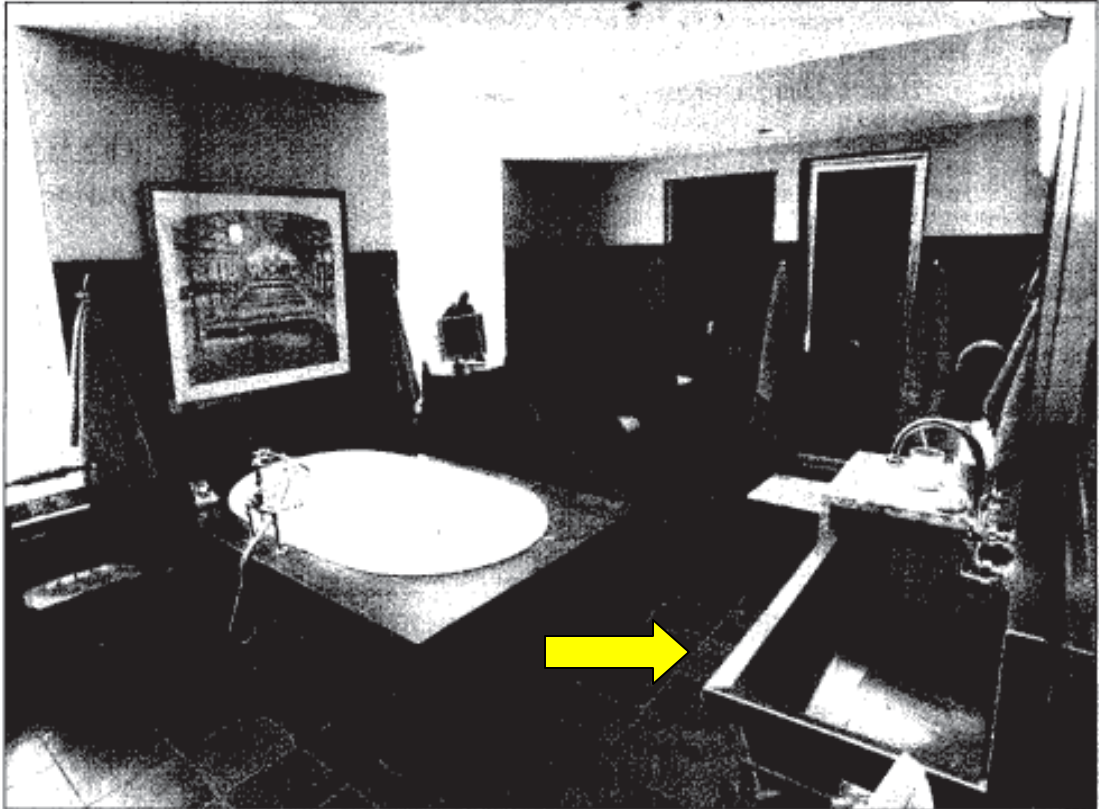

A bathroom with bragging rights

The bathroom in the home of Paul Zurowski in Chicago features an industrial scullery sink and faucets, a granite bench that was turned on its end to provide counter space, and iron and glass shelving from The Container Store. The Kohler Vintage whirlpool tub was \$5,700, the Kohler Vintage tub faucet was \$1,030, and the Black Hones slate tile on the floor and walls was \$15 per square foot. On the other hand, the granite slab C-shaped counter top, custom-made from a remnant, was \$350, iron shelving from The Container Store was \$35 each with custom-cut glass shelf inserts (\$15 each) and the Elkay industrial trough sink was \$2,000 (versus \$8,000 for a custom sink).
