- *Nu Flow's* Atlanta office relocated to Lithia Springs, Ga., in October. The new office has a training facility, a showroom and a fleet maintenance area. It includes 2,500 square feet of office space; 4,000 square feet for vehicles; and 2,000 square feet for the parts warehouse.
